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Terms and conditions

Judges must complete an intense two day face to face training with some online preparation prior to the training. At the end of this training, judges must pass a test for certification. Judges will only be certified in the sections and categories successfully tested on and may only judge those sections written on their certificate. They will be listed as a certified IPSF international judge for one full competitive year. When the year has expired all judges will be required to take part in a re-certification training to ensure all IPSF judges have been updated and trained on all changes and improvements made, upholding the IPSF standards.

WPSC 2014: Certified IPSF international judges chosen to judge at the WPSC 2014 must attend an additional intensive face to face preparation training on 18th July 2014 in London. These judges will be required from 18-20 July 2014, no exceptions. Accommodation will be provided by the IPSF. All transport will be at the cost of the judge.

Dress Code: All judges will be requested to purchase a judging uniform at their own expense. This will consist of a black jacket, full length black trousers, white dress shirt and black court shoes. The IPSF will supply a blue tie and pin which must be returned to the IPSF after the competition has ended. Judges must be in IPSF regulation attire for the duration of the WPSC. The uniform must be worn plain with no embellishments and with closed toe court shoes of no more than ten (10) centimeters or (4) inches high. Any judges found to be in non-regulation clothing will not be allowed to judge.

All judges must adhere to the IPSF ethical code of conduct. All judges must declare a direct association with an athlete that is competing (partnership, coach, friend etc). Judges cannot share accommodation with competing athletes. The exception being a child and parent/legal guardian. It is forbidden for the Judges to talk to athletes regarding all matters concerning World Pole Sports Championships. All requests for feedback must be relayed to the head judge.
